UML Pro Sensor Rearming Instructions

- . Do not detach the inflator from the lifejacket.
- Refer to lifejacket manufacturers instructions prior to re-arming.
- Before commencing the re-arming procedure, ensure you have the correct kit and correct size of CO₂ Cylinder and that the lifejacket is dry.
- Keep away from fluids.
- Ensure the automatic cartridge is within it's Replace by Date.

Step 1

Unscrew the automatic cartridge by turning it anticlockwise and discard in an environmentally friendly manner. Replace it with the new cartridge by turning it clockwise and tighten up hand tight. Ensure the bottom indication turns green.



Step 2

Remove the CO₂ Cylinder by turning it anit-clockwise and discard it in an environmentally friendly manner.



Step 3

If the unit has been manually activated, push the lever back into its slot until it clicks into postion.



Step 4

Ensure the black CO₂Cylinder seal is fitted correctly.



Step 5

Ensure the CO₂ Cylinder cap has not been pierced and then screw it clockwise into the UML Pro Sensor inflator. Tighten up hand tight, ensuring both the top and bottom indicators are green.





- Re-pack the lifejacket according to the lifejacket manufacturers instructions.
- When not in use, store the lifejacket in a cool, dry place out of direct sunlight.
